INDEPENDENT AUDITORS' REPORT

To the Corporation of the County of Prince Edward Kim White, Clerk:

I have audited the accompanying Financial Statement - Form 4 of Steve Ferguson, Candidate, which comprise the Statement of Campaign Income and Expenses and the Calculation of Surplus or Deficit for the campaign period from May 2, 2018 to December 31, 2018 relating to the election held on October 22, 2018. The Financial Statements have been prepared by the Candidate based on the accounting treatment prescribed by the Municipal Elections Act, 1996 (Section 78).

Candidate's Responsibility for the Financial Statements

The Candidate is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of these statements in accordance with the accounting treatment prescribed by the Municipal Elections Act, 1996 (Section 78) and for such internal control as the Candidate determines necessary to enable the preparation of statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

Auditors' Responsibility

My responsibility is to express an opinion on these statements based on my audit. I conducted my audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards. Those standards require that I comply with ethical requirements and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the statements are free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the statements. The procedures selected depend on the auditors' judgment including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the statements, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the Candidate's preparation and fair presentation of the statements in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the Candidate's internal control. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates made by the Candidate, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the statements.

I believe that the audit evidence I have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for my quantified audit opinion.

Basis for Qualified Opinion

Due to the nature of the types of transactions inherent in an election campaign, it is impracticable through audting procedures to determine that the accounting records include all donations of goods and services, and receipts and disbursements. Accordingly, my verification of these transactions was limited to ensuring that the statements reflect the amounts recorded in the accounting records of Steve Ferguson, Candidate in accordance with the accounting procedures established by the Municipal Elections Act, 1996 (Section 78) and I was not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to income and expenses and surplus or deficit.

Qualified Opinion

In my opinion, except for the possible effects of the matter described in the Basis for Qualified Opinion paragraph, the statements present fairly, in all material respects, the income and expenses for the campaign period from May 2, 2018 to December 31, 2018 and the determination of surplus or deficit in accordance with the accounting treatment prescribed by the Municipal Elections Act, 1996 (Section 78).

Basis of Accounting and Restriction on Use and Distribution

Without modifying my opinion, I draw attention to the fact these Financial Statements are prepared in accordance with the accounting treatment prescribed by the Municipal Elections Act, 1996 (Section 78). The Financial Statements are prepared to assist Steve Ferguson, Candidate, to meet the requirements of the County of Prince Edward. My report is intended solely for the Candidate and the County of Prince Edward and should not be distributed to or used by parties other than the Candidate or the County of Prince Edward.
