**Addendum 1 - Slope Stability Investigation Report**

Further to technical comments received from the County and Quinte Conservation, please find outlined below our revisions to the above noted report (issue date August 20, 2018).

The report recommended an erosion hazard limit based on a 1H:1V stable slope plus a 6 m access allowance. The report predates the Quinte Conservation Shoreline Management Plan (SMP) issued in June, 2022. The SMP provides mapping updating the 100 year flood and erosion hazard limits for the County region, thereby eliminating the need to complete Slope Stability Studies (with the exception of unique instances).

Based on the technical comments received on the report and in consultation with Fotenn, the development layout was revised to incorporate the setback requirements based on the updated Shoreline Management Plan.

As such, the erosion hazard limit for the Slope Stability Investigation Report is revised based on a 1.75H:1V slope per the Shoreline Management Plan mapping. All development must be setback a minimum of 6 m from the erosion hazard limit.

The above revision to our report should address the comments received from both the County and Quinte Conservation.
