

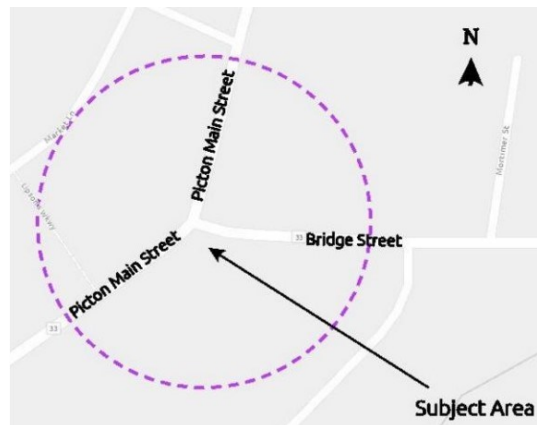
NOTICE OF STUDY COMPLETION
Picton Town Hill Intersection Improvements Study

Introduction

The County of Prince Edward has completed a Schedule B Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (MCEA) (2023) Study for improvements to the operation, safety, and capacity of the existing intersection of Picton Main Street and Bridge Street. The recommended solution is a signalized intersection.

The Process

The Picton Town Hill EA Study was conducted as a Schedule B EA Study under the MCEA (2023). The Study considered improvement alternatives, including reconstruction of the existing intersection as a roundabout or signalized intersection, and developed a Recommended Plan to address the needs of the Study Area.



30-Day Public Review Period of Project File Report

The Project File Report documents the planning process undertaken and details of the study recommendations, as well as potential impacts and mitigation measures. The Project File Report will be available for review online from December 5, 2024 to January 8, 2025 at:

Outstanding Issues After Project File Report Review

In the event there are outstanding issues, a request may be made to the Minister of the Environment, Conservation and Parks for either a Section 16 Order imposing additional conditions or a Section 16 Order requiring an individual environmental assessment on the grounds that the requested order may prevent, mitigate, or remedy adverse impacts on constitutionally protected Aboriginal and treaty rights.
