Indigenous Engagement Documentation

AS&G Archaeological Consulting Inc. (AS&G) was contracted to conduct a Stage 3 Site-Specific Archaeological Assessment of the McDonald Site (AIGh-102), located at 1847 County Road 12, Plan 47R-290, Part of Lot 4, Concession South Side of West Lake, Township of Hallowell, Prince Edward County, Municipality of the County of Prince Edward, Ontario. The proposed development project was triggered by the Planning Act and the Archaeological Assessment was done in advance of a development proposal application. AS&G provided project information (via email on April 4, 2024) to the following five First Nations: Alderville First Nation, Curve Lake First Nation, Hiawatha First Nation, Huron-Wendat First Nation, and the Mohawks of the Bay of Quinte First Nation (MBQFN).

Correspondence included a copy of the Draft Report, as well as a request to review and provide input. The Stage 3 Site-Specific Assessment was conducted between August 28 to September 28, 2023. There were no First Nation Liaisons on site during test unit excavations, as the McDonald Site (AIGh-102) was originally identified as an early to mid-19th century Euro-Canadian homestead or farmstead based on the date range of the artifact assemblage. At the time of submission to the Ministry of Citizenship and Multiculturalism (MCM) the recommendations of this report were prepared in consultation with Curve Lake First Nation and Hiawatha First Nation. Hello Sheryl,

Thank you so much for your email. I have read over the report, and everything looks fantastic! Very interesting on the Euro-Canadian side! I am wondering what your opinion is if you were to excavate on the cardinal points of 495N:300E? Will that cause problems on your end? I feel that if it is all right, maybe save it to the end to see if any additional First Nations artifacts are uncovered elsewhere. We can stay connected on this though and maybe check back if anything in addition is discovered elsewhere. I know this strategy may go against the Standards and Guidelines, but the community has asked that I keep them apprised on all First Nations artifacts discovered in the Territory. So, I am just putting that out as a possibility.

As for the monitoring aspect of the project, I feel that perhaps a liaison is not needed, unless of course in the unlikely event that you uncover a significant amount of First Nations cultural material then we can revisit it. If, of course, you prefer a liaison to be onsite for part or all the project, I can look into our capacity. All I ask is that you stay connected if you are uncovering more First Nations material. I can easily pop down to discuss the community's wishes or we can do so over email or phone. Obviously if you find the remains of any ancestors, please include us in any correspondence once everything has been cleared with the police, coroner, etc. I understand that the police or coroner may need to take photographs, but please ask them to limit them out of respect for the ancestor. My work cell is on my signature below. Please use this if I am not getting back to you quick enough over email or you discover something on a balmy Sunday afternoon.

If you don't mind sending the Stage 4 once complete, that will be much appreciated. If needed, I can provide a letter saying that all of our concerns have been met so it may accompany the report to the Ministry. At the very least, it is nice to have the Stage 4 on file, regardless of what is found, just to close the file.
