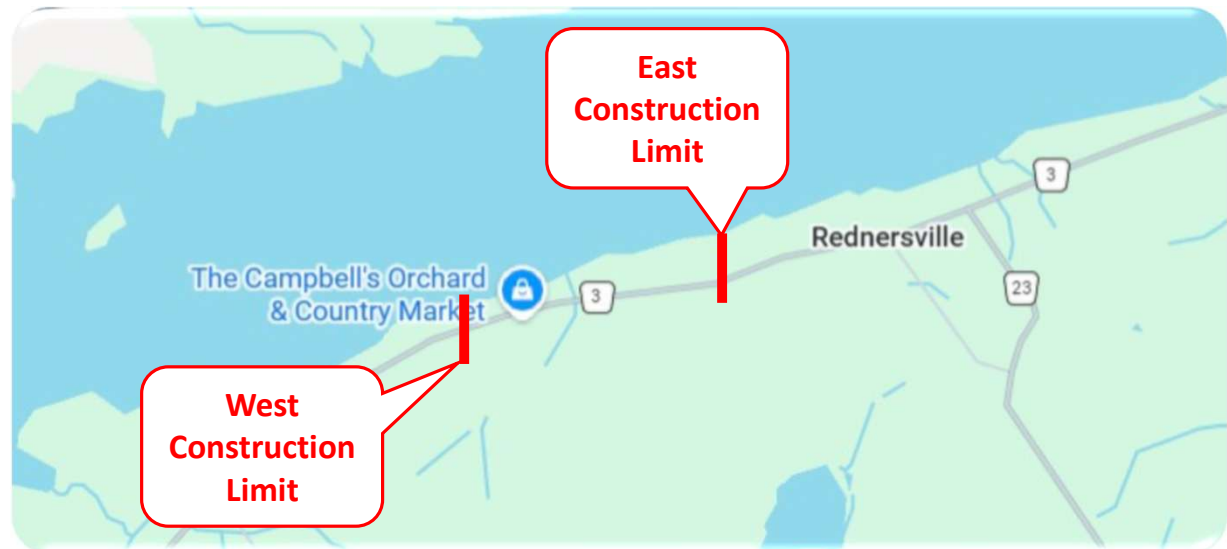

# PROJECT BACKGROUND

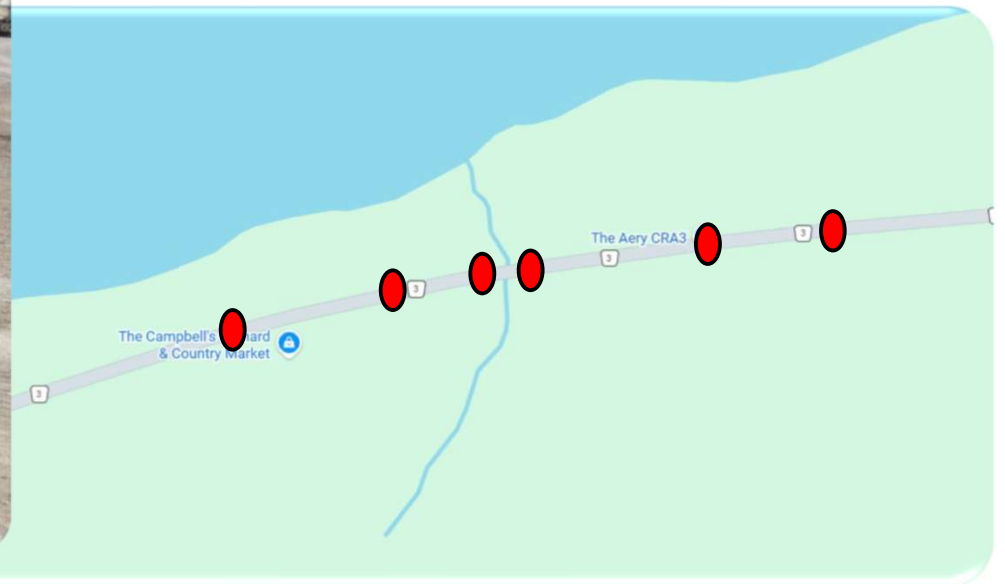
- Project begins where the previous phase of the County Road 3 rehabilitation ended (civic #1460) and continues to the west for approximately 1.0 km (civic #1687).
- Scope of work to include underground road cross-culvert replacements, existing ditch clean out, new asphalt shoulders and road surface, new road line painting.
- Detailed design completed and construction planned for spring 2026!

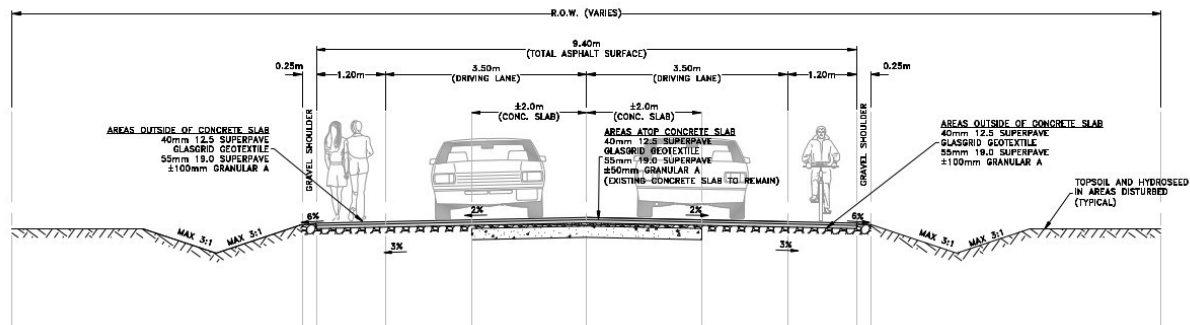
# SCOPE OF WORK - DRAINAGE

- Road cross culverts and driveway culverts in poor condition to be replaced.
- Cross culverts to be replaced shown on the map below.
- Minor ditch improvements and clean-out where necessary.



# SCOPE OF WORK - PAVING

- The full depth of the existing asphalt roadway will be removed and repaved with new hot mix asphalt.
- Includes 1.2m wide paved surface shoulders.
- New line painting following completion of paving.

# EXPECTED IMPACTS TO RESIDENTS & BUSINESSES



## Hours of Work

- Work will take place Monday to Friday from 7am to 7pm.
- All construction related noise must comply with PEC Noise By-Law 143-2022.

## Schedule

- Tender documents stipulate substantial completion by September 1, 2026.



## Driveway Access

- The Contractor will notify and coordinate with residents/Businesses of any temporary restrictions to driveway access in advance of any disruptions.

## Vibration and Dust

- Vibrations may be experienced during construction.
- The Contractor will take the necessary steps to reduce dust caused by the construction, ie: concrete wetting and watering of temporary gravel roadways.

## Emergency Services

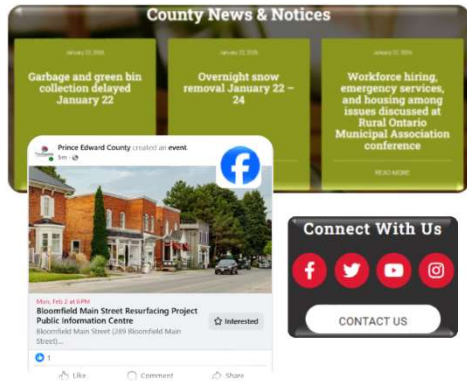
- Emergency access for Paramedics, Police and Fire Services, shall be accommodated at all times.

## Garbage and Recycling Collection

- PEC (contracted to Environmental 360 Solutions) will continue to collect garbage, compost and recycling on the usual day of the week.
- Where necessary, the contractor will bring waste bins to a designated location for collection and return the empty bins to the appropriate address each week.
- It is advised to label your bins with your address to ensure proper return.
