



# Frequently Asked Questions

- 1 What is the PECAHC? It is a Municipal Services Corporation of The County of Prince Edward, with the mandate to increase the stock of affordable rental housing. It was established by Council in 2018, and became a Municipal Services Corporation in 2023. It is a non-profit.
- 
- 2 Who sits on the PECAHC The Board is represented by appointed Councillors and County residents who have legal, construction, fundraising and other skills. The Board is currently looking for public members with land-lease and other alternative ownership models as well as capital fundraising. You can see who is currently on the Board on the Governance team of its website.

- 3 How often does PECAHC meet? The Board meets on the second Monday of the month, at Shire Hall in a hybrid format using Municipal Procedures. Working Groups appointed by the Board meet as needed on their own schedule.

- 4 How does PECAHC work? The PECAHC is supported by Municipal staff, and is governed by its By-Laws, Letters Patent and Service Level Agreement with the Municipality. For the most part, it is administered with by-laws and policies of the Municipality, except for ones it creates itself. The Board elects public members, which are confirmed at Council.

- 5 What are PECAHC's current goals? There are two sites in pre-construction slated for rental housing construction, one in Picton and one in Wellington. Current activities include securing financing, preparing the Wellington site for pre-construction, and working with private and non-profit partners for each site.
