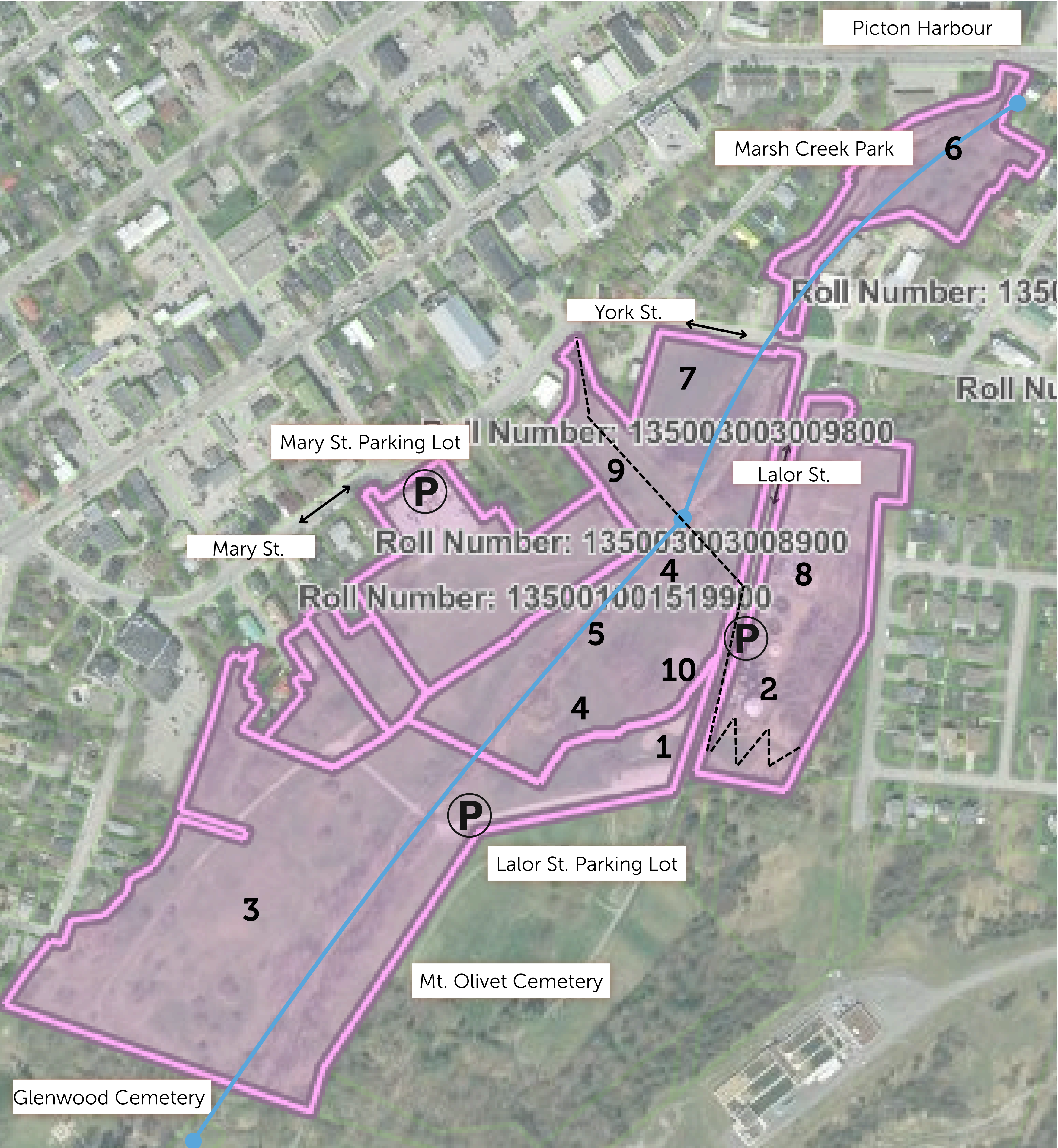

Interest”**

Courts project to become a project of
community interest and that the Prince
Edward Pickleball Committee enter into a
partnership agreement with The County;
and

THAT the location of future courts be
considered as part of the Parks and
Recreation Master Plan and report back
to Council.

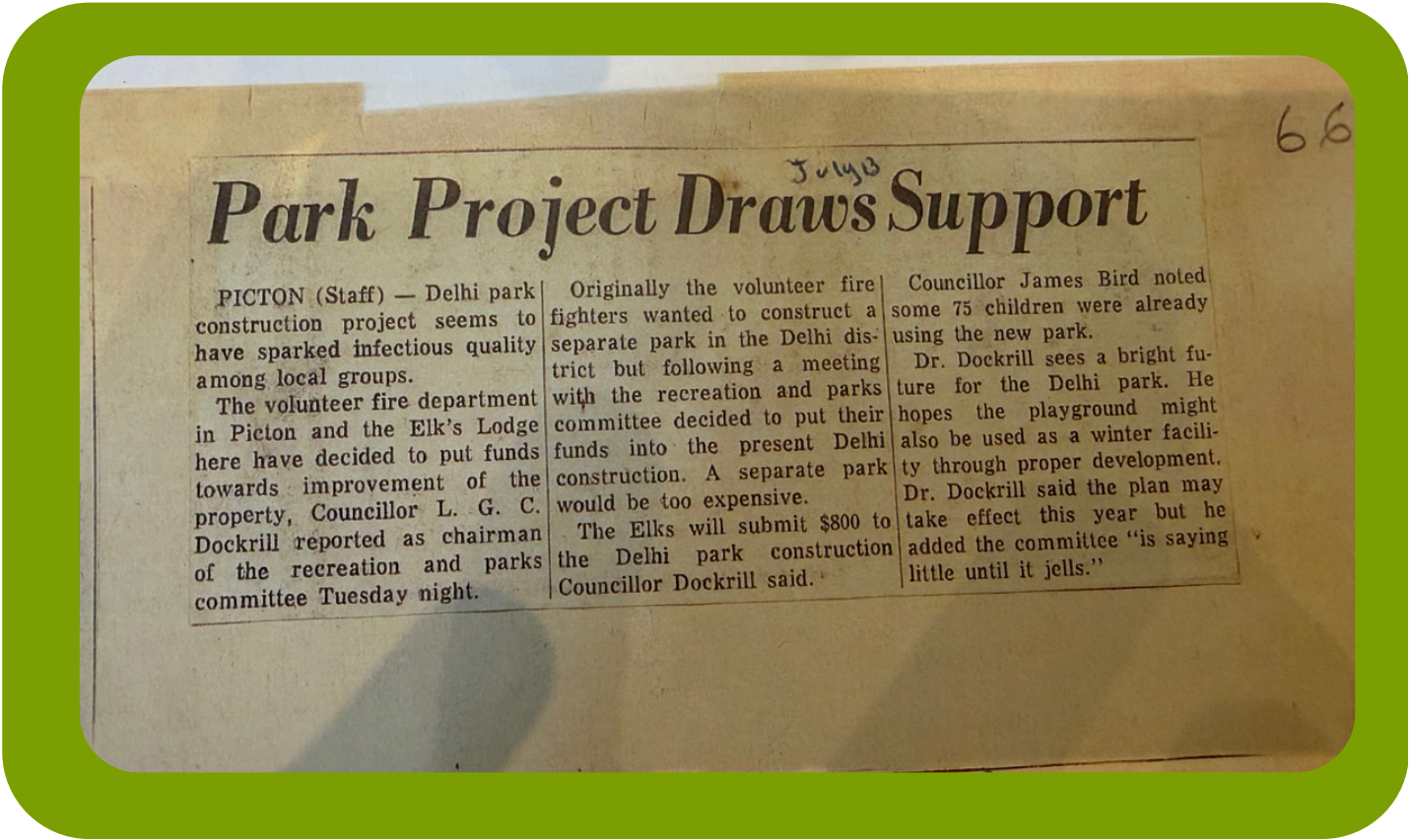
Early 1900s -1979

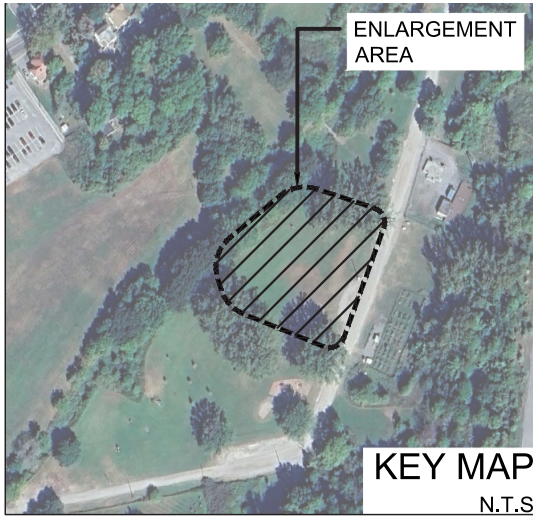
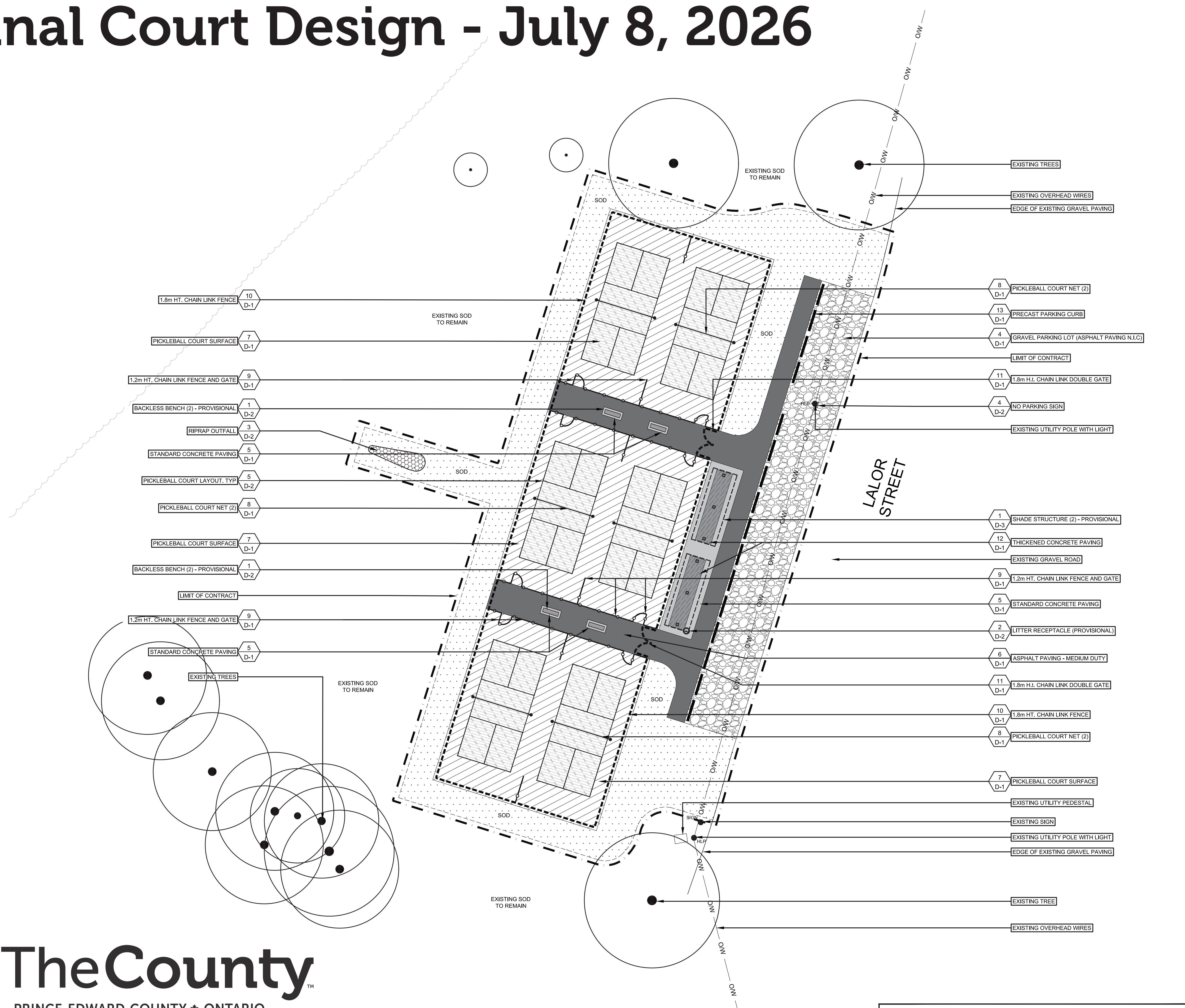

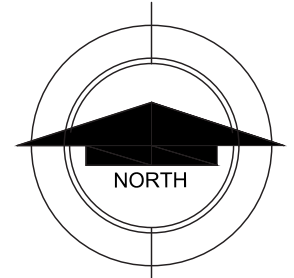

2023 Court project becomes capital project - \$200,000 to be funded by donations

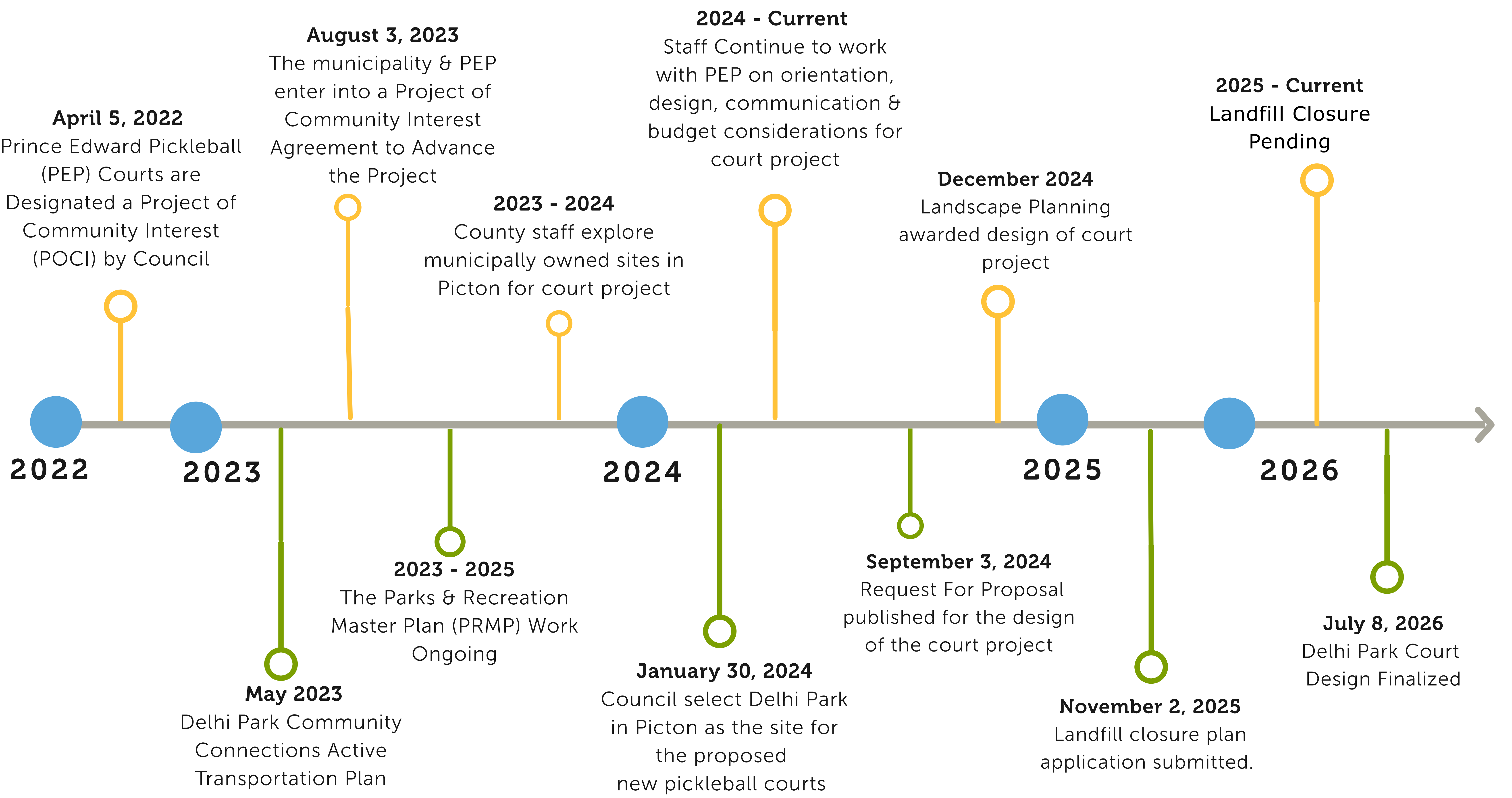
2026 Court capital project budget receives \$133,500 from the Parkland Reserve fund
